Gas tax: To cover all that cost, motorists would pay 12 cents a gallon -- on top of the state tax of 24 cents a gallon. Property owner fee: If the city focuses on this fee, homeowners would pay \$4.50 a month. Businesses that generate a lot of traffic would be hit hardest. Large manufacturers and grocery stores would pay \$550 or more a month.
