Registration Terms and Conditions

Who is eligible?

- You must be the current ratepayer for the property described on this registration form.
- You must be current on your City utility account or are honoring payment arrangements that you have made with the City to get caught up on your delinquent payments.

What is required to qualify?

- You have private stormwater facilities that safely capture and dispose of stormwater that drains from your buildings.
- You have a building or plumbing permit, inspection report, or other documents that describe the size and capacity of the facilities. The documents should provide information to determine that the facilities were properly installed.
- You have maintained the stormwater facilities in good working order, consistent with operations and maintenance requirements established by the manufacturer of the facility or the City of Portland.

How will the City verify my registration?

- By signing this registration form, you are granting the City authority to conduct a limited inspection of the private stormwater facilities described in the registration. The City will arrange the inspections by appointment at time that is mutually convenient.
- The City may revoke the discount, require payment of previous discounts and charge civil penalties if any of the following conditions occur: the City finds that the information on this form is inaccurate; private stormwater management facilities or actions are unsafe or illegal; private stormwater facilities do not comply with building, plumbing and stormwater requirements; or the City is denied an opportunity to conduct a limited site inspection of private stormwater facilities.

How long does the discount award last?

- You will continue to receive stormwater discounts as long as the discount program is offered, you are the person who receives and pays the stormwater charges for the property described in the registration, and you maintain the stormwater facilities in good operating condition.

Low Income Assistance and Earned Income Tax Credits. You may qualify for reduced utility bills, crisis assistance, and income tax credits. These programs are available to ratepayers who meet specific financial standards.

You may qualify for City's low-income utility assistance, if your household income is lower than the amounts shown below:

Household Size	Monthly Household Income Limit
1 person	\$1,566
2 persons	\$2,048
3 persons	\$2,531
4 persons	\$3,013
5 persons	\$3,495
6 persons	\$3,977
7 persons	\$4,067
8 persons	\$4,158

For each additional person add \$90.41 of monthly household income.
These income limits are revised in the fall of each year.

You may qualify for earned income credits, if your annual income is less than the following amounts:

Single Taxpayer – without children	\$11,490
Single Taxpayer – with one child	\$30,338
Single Taxpayer – with 2 or more children	\$34,458
Married filing jointly – without children	\$12,490
Married filing jointly – with one child	\$31,338
Married filing jointly – with 2 or more children	\$35,458
